Church History

A church has stood on the site of St James's for over one thousand years. The present church was built in the 15th century. The towering spire, the tallest of any parish church in England took 15 years to build, reaching its height of 295ft in 1515. The Lincolnshire Rising, commonly known as the Pilgrimage of Grace, which was led by the vicar of Louth, Thomas Kendall, started in Louth in 1536. It was a reaction to rumours of monasteries being closed and church wealth being confiscated. A major restoration scheme was completed in the 19th century by Louth architect, James Fowler. The West Window was installed in 1874 and the East Window was refurbished in 1861. They have just been re-installed in 2008 after a year's cleaning and restoration.
