

Children from Lacey Gardens School dressed as evacuees, chatted with ex-Service personnel and civilians who remember the original VE Celebrations and viewed various WW11 Memorabilia. Stephanie Moon played a medley of tunes on the piano from the era and everyone was then treated to some memorable songs from the GI Girls. Many got into the celebratory spirit by singing along and dancing to the music. Everyone had a memorable and enjoyable time and the Trinity Centre staff received lots of positive feedback. The general feeling was that a repeat performance should be arranged in 2020 to celebrate the 75th anniversary of VE Day.

The fund is comprised of £667k from the Diocese of Lincoln, and £333k from the Government in a match-funded scheme. Grant awards will range between £5,000 and £25,000, with a panel of seven independent trustees sitting four times per year to consider applications.

Applications for grants are invited from any local group in greater Lincolnshire involved in social justice work. Projects eligible for funding include those based around social cohesion, isolation, poverty, the elderly and children and young people.

The closing dates for applications are 14th September, 1st December 2015 and 1st March and 1st June 2016. For more information about applying, please contact:


